1. Welcome
2. Approval of September 2025 Meeting Minutes. Approval by Stephanie Wilson and Sadie Gagner.
3. Principal's Report: Review of goals. PBIS had their first meeting to discuss strategies and goals. The PBIS team consists of: 1 behaviour mentor, 1 Bus representative, 1 custodian, 2 resource, 1 guidance councillor, 3 middle school teachers, 3 high school teachers, 3 administrators. They will be engaging a student for the team as well. It was an introductory meeting.
4. Looking at adjustments to data trackers. New bus violation forms will be replacing the outdated forms. All teachers met with SIP teams to predict behaviour issues. Tardiness and loitering is still an ongoing issue, although there has been improvements with bathroom loitering. The second-floor boys' bathroom upgrades has been completed. Rebecca will discuss with Bus Driver Representative bus tardiness. Total monthly incident reports show that incidents are down for the month of October compared to September. Teachers went from an AI model to an Advisory model; Feedback to follow. The school has a new Mariner award - Teacher Feature. University recruiters were in last week and did on the spot applications. Application fees were waved. University interns will be joining the school for observation. The evacuation procedure went very smoothly. A new printer for signage and communication to be purchased from budget was discussed. Staff and students will be doing surveys and results from these will be back by Christmas.
5. SRC Update: Spirit Assembly for September saw prizes and attendance awards handed out. Perfect attendance was awarded to over 70 kids. The Fall Fair is coming up with games, prizes and the senior splash. The community spook walk is taking place on Wednesday (which will be a Grad Class fundraiser). The spook walk and dance will take place on Thursday. Attendance continues to be high for the SCR meetings, with great involvement for the upcoming events.
